2008 SEASON ALMOST UPON US

The new season of racing kicks off at Darley Moor on Easter Sunday closely followed by the double header weekend of Oulton Park on March 29th and Mallory Park on March 30th. Oulton is already destined to be oversubscribed with the overflow being transferred to Mallory which also looks to be heading for a very good turn out so a strong start to the season is expected.

The European Superkart Championship is also not far away coming the first weekend in April at Nogaro in France. The entry for which was oversubscribed almost immediately and certainly well before close of entry.

The ICC class starts their Championship at Oulton with the F250 Nationals and F125 Opens beginning theirs at Mallory on April 13th. The Division 1 Superkarts begin at Oulton Park on May 26th.

The first Masters Round for each of the two classes is on long circuit this year with the F250 Nationals at Mallory on April 13th and the F125 ICC starting their Masters campaign at Anglesey on May 11th.

Whatever you do this year, be it a full season or the odd events we look forward to seeing you and wish you a great season and good luck.

TRAVEL INFO FOR THE BISHOPSCOURT EVENT

Just to give you some idea of the approximate costs involved the sample costing below is for a Transit style van 6m long and 2.3 m high and including 3 people, all are return prices and is as follows :-

Stranraer to Belfast on HSS is £195

Stranraer to Belfast on the ferry is £165

Birkenhead to Belfast (night) is £315

Birkenhead to Belfast (day) is £185

Vans over 2.3 m high will be a bit higher fair.

For those of you that are not aware Birkenhead is near Liverpool and therefore less driving than Stranraer for many.

As soon as the event SR`s are issued I will send them out to you. The event will however be excellent value for money with an untimed practice, timed qualifier and two counting races for the Championships plus the UK Cup race at the end of the event and all for a very reasonable entry fee.
