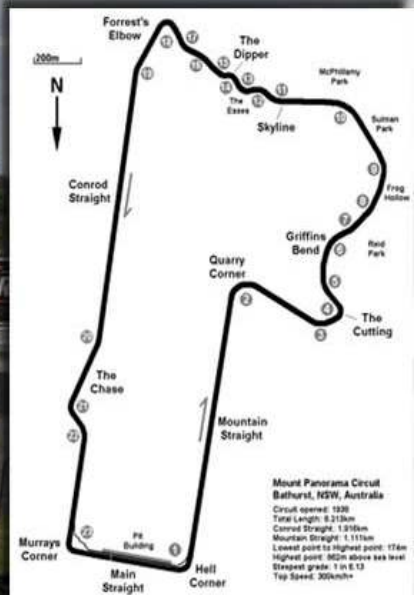

In the interests of giving you the competitor as much time as possible, we took the initiative to release the following subject to an approved track licence.

What a story to tell your grandchildren, or have your family waving proudly as you pass through pit straight, up to the left hander to climb Mountain Straight on another flying lap of the mountain.

A FEW FAST FACTS.

- *6.2 km circuit
- * Conrod Straight is 1.916km long
- *Mountain Straight is 1.111km long
- *Elevation from Pit Straight to Skyline is 174m
- * Steepest grade is 1 in 6.13

WHEN

The Superkart club of NSW has been invited to participate at the **2011 BATHURST 12HR** held on 4th-6th February 2011. Superkarts will be a support category with track time being on the 4th and 5th of February.

TRACK TIME

FRIDAY

2 by 20 minute qualifying sessions

SATURDAY

3 by 20 minute races

A 250 International Superkart in ideal conditions is estimated to complete a lap in around 2.10m minute. In unideal conditions lap times are likely around 2.30m.

COST

***WHAT'S NEXT? YOUR EXPRESSION OF INTEREST,

*ENSURE YOU READ SUPERKART CLUB OF NSW NOTES FIRST

Firstly, this expression is being released now as we are running out of time with a contract deadline approaching, subject to CAMS approval.

*The Superkart Club of NSW has been working on the Mt Panorama venture for close to 12 months now. The proposal submitted to CAMS is a 30+ page document which includes a risk assessment as per CAMS guidelines, comparable graphs on energies/forces in a collision, driver feedback from the test session in the 2010 Bathurst 12HR. Word at present is the document has been read but a formal CAMS meeting is still to take place to give a tick of approval.

*If the approval is given, the NSW Superkart club must sign a contract to participate in late August. These contracts have a risk factor with them meaning, the NSW club is liable for the risk fee whether 1 or 56 competitors participate. This means for NSW to sign a contract of such an amount and know we will not fall over, ALL ENTRY FEES WILL NEED

TO BE PREPAID PRIOR TO NSW SUPERKART CLUB SIGNING A CONTRACT. NO money is expected to be paid by you prior to approval by CAMS being given. Please understand the Superkart Club of NSW cannot do this any differently.

* All information regarding costs and track time has been an early agreement between the promoter and the Superkart Club of NSW.

* **READ CAREFULLY.** The event MUST run with full grid density (56). In saying that, the promoter has offered the following.

-For qualifying, more than 56 are allowed to participate, we'll allow 2 qualifying sessions to hopefully avoid a one off blow up sending a competitor home. IF you qualify OUTSIDE of 56 after 2 sessions, your event is finished, BUT, the promoter will refund you \$500.00 of your entry. The likely ones to miss the cut off will be the RotaxMax class. In saying that, to have your dream come true of participating at Mt Panorama, this is still value for money.

* As no regs will be available by August, the Superkart Club of NSW will ask for a letter stating costs, track time, conditions and anything that a competitor will need to know regarding the event. This letter will be part of the pre entry registration form.

* Anybody competing in a Superkart at Mt Panorama MUST not be on P plates. This condition is not negotiable and is a condition from CAMS. If you are on P plates, we suggest you enter CAMS event now so you can move to your NSK licence.

* If you're not a Superkart Club of NSW member a special membership will be introduced that covers just the event. Cost will only be \$20.00 Australian. The collective membership will allow the Superkart Club of NSW to provide extremely good quality trophies, and also cover incidental costs the NSW Superkart Club will likely encounter at such a prestigious event.
